

# MD BoS HMIS: Joint Program Components TH / RRH

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The HMIS workflow for entering clients into *either* of the Joint **TH** / **RRH** project components is basically the same as any stand-alone TH &/or RHH project.

- One of the main **DIFFERENCES** is determining the clients **ENTRY / EXIT dates** from each of the Joint **TH** / **RRH** components

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The Entry Date for enrolling clients into the **Joint TH** / **Joint RRH** project components **can vary** depending on the situation. A few scenarios are covered in upcoming slides.

Some main points to remember are:

- It is the client's choice whether they participate in either **Joint TH** &/or **Joint RRH** project components
- Clients are **only** enrolled into the **Joint TH** project on the date they begin residing the **Joint TH** bed
- Clients in **both** components are exited from **Joint TH** once a Housing Move-in-Date (HMID) is recorded in the **Joint RRH** project (more info on slide 4)

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## Joint TH Project

Clients that are determined eligible **and** opt to participate in the **Joint TH** project:

- **Entry Date:**
  - If a client is eligible for the **Joint TH** project – *BUT* project **DOES NOT** have a **Joint TH** bed available, **do not enroll** until they actually begin residing in a **Joint TH** bed
- **Exit Date:**
  - For clients that are also enrolled in the **Joint RRH** project:
    - Once housing is secured, record the HMID in the HMIS **Joint RRH** assessment
    - **Exit** client from the **Joint TH** project – using the same date as the **HMID**
  - Clients that no longer want to participate in the **Joint TH** project **&/or** find a housing solution outside of your agency – exit them from the **Joint TH** project

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- **Housing Move-in Date (HMID)**: The HMID is used to differentiate clients who are **housed** in the **Joint RRH** project from those who were *not* – **&/or** – *only received services* in the **Joint TH** project
- **HMID = Joint TH Exit**:
  - ✓ When a client that is also participating in the **Joint RRH** project moves into housing, record a HMID in the **Joint RRH** assessment
  - ✓ And **exit** them from the **Joint TH** project **using the same date** as the **HMID**
- **Clients that exit without a HMID**: In situations where a client exits *without moving into permanent housing*, you simply exit them from both the **Joint TH** project & the **Joint RRH** project **without** an **HMID** recorded in the **Joint RRH** project

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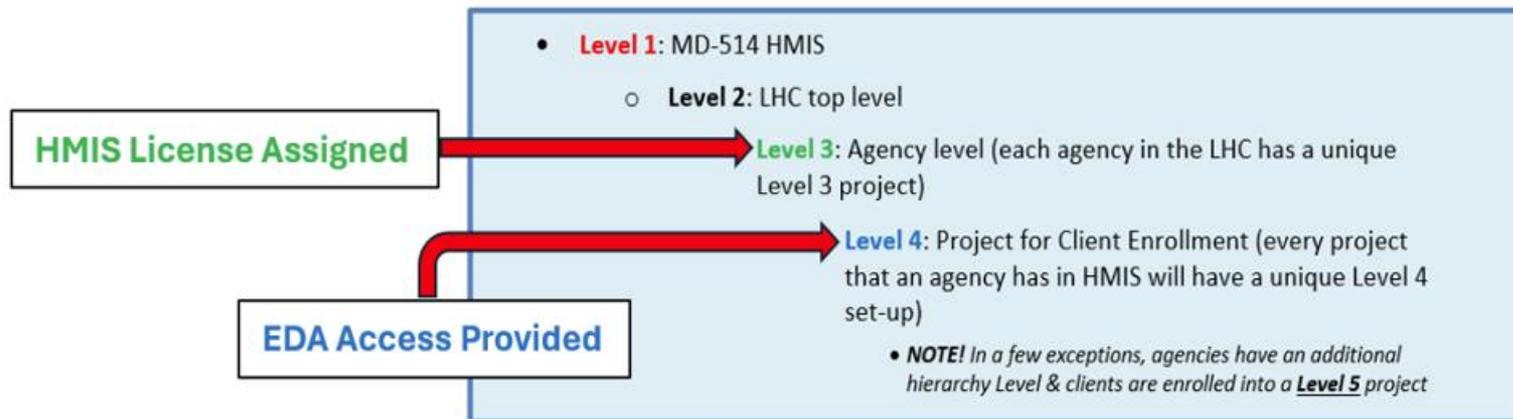
## Joint RRH Project

Clients that are determined eligible **and** opt to participate in the **Joint RRH** project:

- **Entry Date:**
  - If at the time eligibility is determined the client opts NOT to participate in the **Joint RRH** project – BUT later changes their mind, the **Entry Date** will be the date they **opted in**
- **!! Housing Move-in-Date!!**
  - ✓ Once housing is secured, record the **HMID** in the HMIS **Joint RRH** assessment
    - **Exit** client from the **Joint TH** project – using the same date as the **HMID**
- **Exit Date:**
  - When services in the **Joint RRH** project end &/or client opts to leave the project

- **Before Starting Any Data Entry – REMEMBER to:**
  - Enter Data As (EDA)
  - Back Date Mode (if necessary)
